### The Direct Debit Guarantee

- The Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that take part in the Direct Debit Scheme. The efficiency and security of the scheme is monitored and protected by your own Bank or Building Society.

- If the amounts to be paid or the payment dates change, you will normally be given 14 days notice by the organisation so that you have time to query the bill if necessary.
- If an error is made by the organisation or your Bank or Building Society you are

guaranteed a full and immediate refund from your branch of the amount paid.

- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by writing to your Bank or Building Society. Please also send a copy of your letter to the organisation concerned.

**Banks and Building Societies may not accept Direct Debit Instructions from some type of accounts.**
