## Assembly

1. Place grey side up and crease down the middle (marked 1)
2. Fold in corners, along lines marked 2
3. Fold in along lines marked 3
4. Turn the sheet over
5. Fold in along the middle (1)
6. Fold wings back along the vertical lines marked 4
