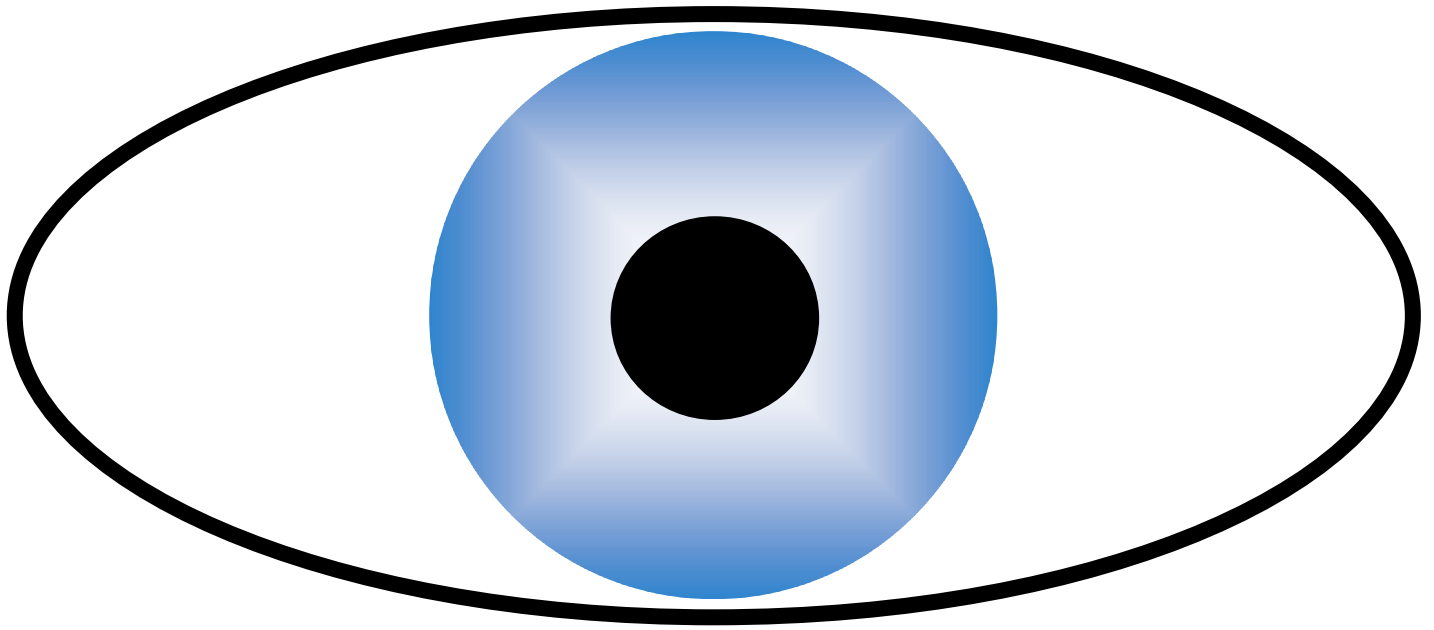

# Question Time on Civil Liberties

Have your say - Show you care

Many of our rights are being eroded:

- we are set to introduce the most intrusive ID Card system in the world (ID Card Act 2006)
- our correspondence is logged (communications and data retention)
- our car journeys recorded (ANPR)
- our travel plans scrutinised (e-borders)
- our judicial rights altered or taken away (various terrorism and crime acts)
- new powers for Government/Council agencies (Police, Revenue and Customs, Bailiffs, Borders Agency)
- the Police are politicised (environmental protest; stop and search; using laws beyond the purpose for which they were intended)
- surveillance cameras everywhere

New Labour have also rushed, unchecked into database solutions without a debate to establish whether it is desirable or ethical.

But what do we know of the policies of the opposition parties? Shami Chakrabati uses this rhetorical question “Have you ever noticed that, whatever happens, at each election, the Government always gets in?”

Privacy is the greatest defence we have against an over-powerful state, but our privacy is fast being devalued or eliminated. We are in uncharted waters. If we (NO2ID, Liberty, Amnesty etc) end up on the losing side, there may be no going back.
